

Different Schemes run by District Industries Centre, Doda

SSI Sector

The District Industries Centre Doda was set up on the central pattern for promotion and development of small scale industries within the district. The Distt. Industries Centre Doda renders the following services to the entrepreneurs under SSI Sector:

1. It provides loan facility to the entrepreneurs through financial institutions to set up their projects.
2. It provides technical guidance to the entrepreneurs for their units and prepares the project report.
3. Under the scheme, the unit is provisionally registered with the DIC and when it is established this office grants formal / permanent registration.
4. When the unit is formally registered, the following incentives are provided to the entrepreneurs as per the J&K State Industrial Policy and Industrial policy of Govt. of India.

i) 30% Capital Investment Subsidy on fixed investment I,e plant & Machinery.

ii) 100% subsidy on D.G. Set.

iii) 90% transport subsidy from rail head complex to factory site, in case the material is purchased from outside the state and finished goods exported to outside the state.

iv) 15% price Preference to registered units over other unregistered units in case of Govt. tendering for their products.

V. 100% reimbursement on charge made to ITCO for preparation of project.

Vi. 50% seed money/earnest money to be charged from Industrial unit

Vii. Toll Tax /VAT Exemption to Industrial units from 2nd of October 2006.The above scheme is administered by Ministry of MSME Govt.of India under the scheme Micro units is covered upto Rs , 25 lakh and small Industrial units up to Rs. 5.00 crore.In order to push the Industrial Development in the District .The Govt.has sanctioned Industrial estate whereby all the facilities would be provided to the Industrial units like power,water,land,etc. so Industrial growth is accelerated in a cluster which has proved quite successful.

Prime Minister Employment Generation Programme.

The PMEGP scheme was launched by the Ministry of MSME, Govt. Of India, to boost and accelerate Industrial growth and Employment avenues all over India. Under the scheme the Nodal agency at the central level which monitors the scheme is KVIC.

The scheme is implemented by the KVIB in rural areas and DIC both at urban and Rural areas. The various parameters of the scheme are as follows.

1, Maximum Project size.

Rs. 25.00 lakh for manufacture sector and Rs.10.00 lakhs for service sector.

2.Education Qualification.

Minimum 8th pass for the project cost above Rs.10,00 lakh under manufacture sector and above Rs.,5.00 lakh project cost under service sector.

3. E.D.P.Training.

2 Weeks E.D.P. training is mandatory. After completing EDP training, first instalment of Bank loan will be released.

4. How to apply.

The scheme will be advertised through print and electronic media. The following documents are required to be submitted.

i. Educational Qualification.(2) Technical Qualification (3) Caste certificate if applicable residency proof.(4) Land documents/rent deed site plan (5) affidavit.

5. Selection of Beneficiary.

The beneficiary will be selected through interview process by the District Task force committee headed by District Development commissioner,

6. Project sanction.

Project will be sanctioned by financing branches of the banks as per techno economic viability.

7. Amount of Bank loan.

Bank sanctions and releases 90-95 % loan of the project cost.

8. Own contribution.

10% of the project cost in case of General category and 5% in case of weaker section beneficiary .

10. Physical verification.

As a monitoring part and to know the impact of the scheme and to ensure the utilization of Govt. subsidy 100% Physical verification will be conducted by state / zonal/National level.

11. Industry groups.

Agro and food processing Industry, forest based Industry, Handmade paper/fiber, Mineral based Industry polymer and chemical Industry ,Rural Engineering and Bio Technology ,service Industry including textiles.

Potential of Industrial units in Erstwhile District Doda

The erstwhile District Doda is one of the most backward District in J&K state . The people of the District are dependent on Agriculture. The land is hilly and rain fed as such prone to drought. The per capita income of the District is the lowest in J&K . There is no Industrial development in District Doda in view of hilly terrain, poor road infrastructure, inadequate power supply, non centralized market, lack of entrepreneurship among educated youths of District Doda. However, in spite of above impediments some of the entrepreneurs have come forward and established units with active assistance of DIC Doda .The following units have good scope in District Doda.

1. Stone crusher and hot mixing plant.

In view of widening of national highway from Batote to Kishtwar and Bhadarwah pul Doda as also availability of raw material in the District the scope for the activity is in abundance.

2. Plaster of Paris:

Due to availability of Gypsum at Assar, the sope for the said activity is sufficient.

3. Fruit processing unit:

Most of the area of District Doda is fruit growing. As such there is good scope for fruit processing unit i.e. Jam, juice,etc.

4. Dhoop Industry:

Major portion of District Doda is covered with forest wherein production of Dhoop is in abundance. As such if Govt. allows the scope for the said activity is in abundance.

5. Herbal processing.

Due to availability of herbs of different species in the forest of District Doda, the scope for herbal processing is abundance subject to permission from the forests department.

6. Walnut processing:

Due to production of walnuts in District Doda, the scope for walnut processing is good in District Doda

7. Brick kiln:

Due to huge construction in District Doda, the scope of Brick kiln is enough.

8. Honey processing unit:

The scope for the unit is good in the District in view of favorable environment for Bee keeping in the District.

9. Auto workshop /service station unit:

Due to increased vehicles in the District, the scope for the above activity is good.

10. Steel fabrication:

The scope for manufacture of Gates, Grills, steel furniture, steel door and windows is good In view of restriction of forest wood.

11. Bakery unit:

Due to increased demand the scope for the activity is good.

12. Cattle/Poultry feed.

Due to increased cattle/poultry farming in the District the demand for cattle /poultry feed is good.

13. Wooden furniture:

The scope for wooden furniture is good in view of availability of raw material.

14. Tyre retreading:

Due to increased vehicles in the District the scope for Tyre retreading is enough.

15. Ice /Ice candy.

The scope for the said activity is enough in the District .However, the unit is seasonal in nature.

16. Computerized Data processing:

In view of computerization in all public/private offices the scope for the activity is good.
